Policy No. 3114 Students

HOME-BASED INSTRUCTION

The Anacortes School District recognizes a parent's right to provide Home Based Instruction pursuant to the provisions of Washington State Law. Students will be considered as receiving home-based instruction when the Parent or Guardian completes and returns to the district a signed Home Based Instruction *Declaration of Intent* form. No student shall be considered as receiving Home Based Instruction unless this form is on file with the district by September 15 or within two weeks of the beginning of any quarter, trimester, or semester. The Home Based Instruction *Declaration of Intent* form is good for one year only and must be filed annually.

Students who are registered with the district as receiving Home Based Instruction may enroll in district schools as part-time students and/or receive ancillary services provided that the student is otherwise eligible for full-time enrollment in the district. A part-time enrolled student is defined as one attending for less than full-time. Full-time enrollment at the elementary school level is defined as regular attendance for the full school day. A full-time student at the middle and high school levels is defined as being in attendance for at least five hours per day.

A student receiving Home Based Instruction that is otherwise eligible for full-time enrollment in the district, may be a member of the Associated Student Body if participating in extra-curricular programs, receiving ancillary services, or is enrolled on a part-time basis. Students receiving Home Based Instruction that wish to participate in extra-curricular programs, ancillary services, and/or part-time enrollment will be subject to the same requirements, rules, and regulations as full-time students.

The superintendent is directed to establish procedures that define the district's responsibilities for home-based and off-campus instruction.
